Once the office has been notified enough times of vandalism issues, then they will send officers to patrol our neighborhood during down times. We will only get these patrols if the sheriffs department sees an increase of problems in our community. The appearance of police in the neighborhood will be a great deterrent for future violations, so please report any incident to PASCO CO. SHERIFF NON EMERGENCY at 727-844-7711.

A NEIGHBORHOOD DIRECTORY has been requested by several residents. We will be putting this together in the near future. Ideally, we want to include the homeowner's name(s), their address and phone number.
